WOOD

One of the key factories ensuring the highest quality is wood and how wood is processed. Our windows are produced using laminated wood beams in the Nordic pine and oak. Other type of wood such as Mahogany, Sapele and Siberian larch can be both: solid and glued beams. All wood which we are using has FSC certification. It means that wood are from forest that are 100% replanted.

WOOD TYPES:

NORDIC PINE - is from slow-grown northern forest (Siberia, Karelia). Wood is soft, medium in weight, has medium density and also has excellent fiber and characteristics: tight growth rings, resulting natural strength. The heartwood is naturally resistant to decay and can also withstand attacks by insects.

OAK - The quality of oak is truly remarkable. Oak wood has a density of about 0.75 g/cm creating great strength and hardness. It is very resistant to insect and fungal attack, also it is durable even in contact with moisture beyond all common belief. Oak is characterized as durable, long lasting with a bright and strong wood texture.

SAPELE - is hard and very durable hardwood. Solid Sapele is generally stable when dry, making it ideal for use in doors and windows. It is ideal for painted applications due to its fine graining. Sapele also has the attractive aroma resistant to insects.

SIBERIAN LARCH: siberian larch timber is naturally beautiful – thats why no finishing required. This tree is one of the best coniferous woods in the forest, with excellent properties:

- Much lower moisture absorption levels compared with fir.
- · Impregnation unnecessary.
- · High durability and very resistant to rot and fungus.
- High mechanical resistance and very good pressure resistance.
- · Excellent wear resistance (Class II).
- · High density.
- Aesthetically pleasing to the eye; warm colours from golden brown to yellow sand, orange in the heartwood.



GLAZING

Sash windows are glazed with double-glazed units which incorporate an advanced thermally insulating glass to provide extremely low U-values. The efficiency is further improved by filling cavity with Argon Gas and low conductivity WARM EDGE SPACER bars to minimize heat loss on the edges and result in centre pane U-values of 1.0 W/m.

High light transmittance (75%+) maximizes the entry of sun light into your home. As well as our range of clear glass options, we also have a wide choice of etched glass and extensive obscure patterned glass available in any of our windows.

TOUGHENED GLASS - for strenght and breakage-resistance, temper glasses often is the first consideration.

Toughened laminated glass is four to five times stronger than standard float glass of the same thickness. This type of tempered glass offers high performance and strength under extreme pressures and is less prone to breakage.

LAMINATED GLASS - For flexibility, UV-resistance, security and sound considerations, laminated glass is often the product of choice. It provides additional security over toughened unit. When smashed, laminated glass holds in place and does not break up into hundreds of little pieces. Instead, it keeps in place long enough for a replacement to be found. Typically, laminated glass products are slightly higher price than tempered products of the same type and thickness.

OBSCURE GLASS - gives privacy and style to windows. Obscure glass ranges from offering very slight distortion to completely hiding the items in question from view or revealing only silhouettes.

To improve security, all our windows are glazed internally which makes it impossible for intruders to gain entry by removing the glass.

All double glazed units are designed with drainage and ventilation channels which helps to prevent timber frame from humidity using condensation grooves.





The box-sash window is mainly a British commodity that is most found on Georgian and Victorian households.

Langvalda sash box windows are constructed to deliver the highest standards of insulation, security and longevity.


It is made with pulleys and weights to control the opening. Traditional sash boxes are the most suitable for traditional British houses.







This classic yet modern design of casement window is a perfect addition to properties both old and new.








Entrance doors 90/115 mm frame

Inside opening frame




Outside opening frame
